## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 367

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 16 and insert:
2	"SECTION 2. (1) A health care provider may disclose protected health information con
3	cerning an inmate of a Department of Corrections facility to the physician of an employee
4	of the department, without an authorization from the inmate or a personal representative
5	of the inmate, if:
6	"(a) The employee, in the performance of the employee's official duties, was exposed to
7	the bodily fluids of the inmate;
8	"(b) The exposure was substantial; and
9	"(c) The inmate has tested positive for HIV or hepatitis B or C or other communicable
10	disease that may be transmitted through an individual's bodily fluids.
11	"(2) A disclosure under subsection (1) of this section must be limited to the minimum
12	necessary to inform the physician of possible exposure to HIV, hepatitis B or C or other
13	communicable disease.".
