

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 37

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 34 through 42 and insert:

2 “(4)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, a passenger endorsement author-
3 izes a person to operate a vehicle:

4 “(A) Described in ORS 801.208 (1)(a) or (b) that is designed to transport passengers in commerce;
5 or

6 “(B) Described in ORS 801.208 (1)(c).

7 “(b) A passenger endorsement does not authorize a person to operate a school bus.”.

8 On page 5, delete lines 26 through 38 and insert:

9 “**SECTION 6.** ORS 807.100 is amended to read:

10 “807.100. (1) The Department of Transportation may not issue or renew commercial driving
11 privileges and may cancel commercial driving privileges **for a person** if the [*person does not submit*
12 *to the department, in a form approved by rule,*] **department has not received and recorded, in the**
13 **form approved by the department,** proof of **the person’s** medical qualification to operate a com-
14 mercial motor vehicle by [*such a*] **the** date [*as required by rule*] **specified** by the department.

15 “(2) A person is entitled to administrative review under ORS 809.440 when the department does
16 not issue or renew commercial driving privileges under this section or cancels commercial driving
17 privileges under this section.

18 “[*(3) To the extent possible, rules adopted by the department under this section should be uniform*
19 *with any applicable federal regulations related to commercial driver license medical qualifications.*]

20 “**(3) The department shall adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.**”.

21 On page 8, line 7, delete “that is not designed for transportation,”.
