

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 380

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert “creating
2 new provisions; amending ORS 390.124; and prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 22 through 26 and insert:

4 “(3) If the commission adopts rules that allow a person to make reservations for the use of
5 campsites established and maintained by the department, the rules shall require the department to
6 identify and set aside 10 percent of the campsites available at each state park where campsite res-
7 ervations are permitted, or four campsites, whichever is more, to be available only for reservation,
8 upon the showing of proper identification, by a disabled veteran. The restriction on reservations
9 under this subsection shall apply only during the first 30 days of any applicable reservation
10 period.”.

11 After line 28, insert:

12 “**SECTION 2. On or before February 15, 2018, the State Parks and Recreation Department**
13 **shall report to the Senate Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness in the**
14 **manner provided in ORS 192.245 on implementation of the amendments to ORS 390.124 by**
15 **section 1 of this 2017 Act.**

16 “**SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.**

17 “**SECTION 4. (1) The amendments to ORS 390.124 by section 1 of this 2017 Act become**
18 **operative January 1, 2018.**

19 “**(2) The State Parks and Recreation Commission and the State Parks and Recreation**
20 **Department may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this**
21 **section that is necessary to enable the commission and the department to exercise, on and**
22 **after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions**
23 **and powers conferred on the commission and the department by the amendments to ORS**
24 **390.124 by section 1 of this 2017 Act.**

25 “**SECTION 5. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017**
26 **regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**”.
