

Senate Bill 393

Sponsored by Senator FERRIOLI (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs state agency of executive department that establishes policy providing that agency will refrain from enforcing law to report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state agency policies providing that agency will not enforce law.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. An agency of the executive department, as defined in ORS 174.112, that es-**
5 **tablishes an informal or formal policy providing that the agency will refrain from enforcing**
6 **a law shall report promptly to a committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly**
7 **on the policy and on the reason for refraining from enforcing the law.**
