Senate Bill 415

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires executive department public body that, as of January 1, 2017, maintained two or more full-time equivalent positions predominantly dedicated to public relations work on behalf of public body to repurpose one full-time equivalent position so as to prioritize responding to public records requests above all other duties and work responsibilities.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
 - (a) "Executive department" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.112.
 - (b) "Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 192.410.
 - (2) Each executive department public body that, as of January 1, 2017, maintained two or more full-time equivalent positions predominantly dedicated to public relations work on behalf of the public body shall repurpose one full-time equivalent position so as to prioritize responding to public records requests above all other duties and work responsibilities of the position.
 - SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
