## Senate Bill 455

Sponsored by Senator THOMSEN (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Freezes minimum wage rate for certain agricultural employers that experience lower than average commodity values. Authorizes Director of Agriculture to create rules.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to commodity fluctuations that affect an agricultural employer's ability to pay current
3	minimum wage.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. (1) For each hour of work time that an agricultural worker as defined in
6	ORS 315.163 is gainfully employed, no employer shall employ or agree to employ the agricul-
7	tural worker at wages computed at a rate lower than the rate described in ORS 653.025 un-
8	less:
9	(a) The value of an agricultural commodity produced by the employer in a calendar year
10	falls below 80 percent of the 10-year average value for that commodity; and
11	(b) The commodity or commodities described in paragraph (a) of this subsection account
12	for 30 percent or more of the general revenue of the employer.
13	(2) An employer that meets the conditions described in subsection (1) of this section may
14	employ an agricultural worker at the rate in effect on July 1 of the previous year under ORS
15	653.025.
16	SECTION 2. The Director of Agriculture may adopt rules necessary for the implementa-
17	tion and enforcement of section 1 of this 2017 Act.
