Senate Bill 472

Sponsored by Senator BOQUIST (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires State Parks and Recreation Commission to develop wayside memorial to Senator Alan Bates adjacent to certain segment of Rogue Scenic Waterway.

Prohibits certain placer mining using motorized equipment within certain segment of Rogue Scenic Waterway.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to a state park memorial for Senator Alan Bates.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The State Parks and Recreation Commission shall develop, and shall acquire by purchase, agreement or donation any real property or right or interest in real property necessary to develop, a wayside memorial for Oregon State Senator Alan Bates, to be located in an area adjacent to the segment of the Rogue Scenic Waterway as described in ORS 390.826 from Lost Creek Dam (near river mile 157), downstream to the confluence of the Rogue River with the Applegate River.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 390.835, the permit requirements of ORS 196.810 and the provisions of ORS 196.800 (3) and (13), mining that uses any form of motorized equipment for the purpose of extracting gold, silver or any other precious metal from placer deposits may not be permitted on waters within the segment of the Rogue Scenic Waterway as described in ORS 390.826 from Lost Creek Dam (near river mile 157), downstream to the confluence of the Rogue River with the Applegate River.
