

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 48

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 6 through 25 and delete page 2 and insert:
2 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**
3 **“(a) ‘Board’ means:**
4 **“(A) Occupational Therapy Licensing Board;**
5 **“(B) Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists;**
6 **“(C) Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine;**
7 **“(D) Oregon Medical Board;**
8 **“(E) Oregon State Board of Nursing;**
9 **“(F) Physical Therapist Licensing Board;**
10 **“(G) State Board of Chiropractic Examiners;**
11 **“(H) State Board of Licensed Social Workers;**
12 **“(I) State Board of Psychologist Examiners; and**
13 **“(J) Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.**
14 **“(b) ‘Licensee’ means a person authorized to practice one of the following professions:**
15 **“(A) Clinical social worker, as defined in ORS 675.510;**
16 **“(B) Licensed marriage and family therapist, as defined in ORS 675.705;**
17 **“(C) Licensed professional counselor, as defined in ORS 675.705;**
18 **“(D) Licensed psychologist, as defined in ORS 675.010;**
19 **“(E) Occupational therapist, as defined in ORS 675.210;**
20 **“(F) Regulated social worker, as defined in ORS 675.510;**
21 **“(G) School counselor, as defined by rule by the Teacher Standards and Practices Com-**
22 **mission;**
23 **“(H) Certified registered nurse anesthetist, as defined in ORS 678.245;**
24 **“(I) Chiropractic physician, as defined in ORS 684.010;**
25 **“(J) Clinical nurse specialist, as defined in ORS 678.010;**
26 **“(K) Naturopathic physician, as defined in ORS 685.010;**
27 **“(L) Nurse practitioner, as defined in ORS 678.010;**
28 **“(M) Physician, as defined in ORS 677.010;**
29 **“(N) Physician assistant, as defined in ORS 677.495;**
30 **“(O) Physical therapist, as defined in ORS 688.010; and**
31 **“(P) Physical therapist assistant, as defined in ORS 688.010.**
32 **“(2) In collaboration with the Oregon Health Authority, a board shall adopt rules to re-**
33 **quire a licensee regulated by the board to report to the board, upon reauthorization to**
34 **practice, the licensee’s completion of any continuing education regarding suicide risk as-**
35 **essment, treatment and management.**

1 “(3) A licensee shall report the completion of any continuing education described in sub-
2 section (2) of this section to the board that regulates the licensee.

3 “(4)(a) A board shall document completion of any continuing education described in sub-
4 section (2) of this section by a licensee regulated by the board. The board shall document the
5 following data:

6 “(A) The number of licensees who complete continuing education described in subsection
7 (2) of this section;

8 “(B) The percentage of the total of all licensees who complete the continuing education;

9 “(C) The counties in which licensees who complete the continuing education practice; and

10 “(D) The contact information for licensees willing to share information about suicide risk
11 assessment, treatment and management with the authority.

12 “(b) The board shall remove any personally identifying information from the data sub-
13 mitted to the board under this subsection, except for the personally identifying information
14 of licensees willing to share such information with the authority.

15 “(c) For purposes of documenting completion of continuing education under this sub-
16 section, a board may adopt rules requiring licensees to submit documentation of completion
17 to the board.

18 “(5) A board, on or before March 1 of each even-numbered year, shall report to the au-
19 thority on the data documented under subsection (4) of this section, as well as information
20 about any initiatives by the board to promote suicide risk assessment, treatment and man-
21 agement among its licensees.

22 “(6) The authority, on or before August 1 of each even-numbered year, shall report to the
23 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care on the information
24 submitted to the authority under subsection (5) of this section. The authority shall include
25 in the report information about initiatives by boards to promote awareness about suicide risk
26 assessment, treatment and management and information on how boards are promoting con-
27 tinuing education described in subsection (2) of this section to licensees.

28 “(7) The authority may use the information submitted to the authority under subsection
29 (5) of this section to develop continuing education opportunities related to suicide risk as-
30 sessment, treatment and management for licensees and to facilitate improvements in suicide
31 risk assessment, treatment and management efforts in this state.

32 “**SECTION 2.** (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop a list of continuing education op-
33 portunities related to”.
