

# Senate Bill 484

Sponsored by Senator PROZANSKI (at the request of Partnership for Safety and Justice) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Department of Corrections to allocate moneys for purpose of funding facilitated dialogue program services necessary to comply with victims' rights.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to victims' right to facilitated dialogue.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and each biennium thereafter, the**  
5 **Department of Corrections may allocate \$\_\_\_\_\_ from the Department of Corrections**  
6 **Account for the purpose of funding facilitated dialogue program services necessary to comply**  
7 **with victims' rights.**
