SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Board of Pharmacy to conduct study for purpose of determining whether plant mitragyna speciosa and drug derivatives of plant should be scheduled as controlled substance. Sunsets January 2, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to kratom; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Board of Pharmacy shall conduct a study for the purpose of

5 determining whether the plant mitragyna speciosa and drug derivatives of the plant 6 mitragyna speciosa should be scheduled as a controlled substance and, if so, what class of

7 schedule the plant and drug derivatives should be.

8 (2) After conducting the study described in subsection (1) of this section, the board shall 9 report the findings of the study in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the interim com-10 mittee of the Legislative Assembly related to health. As part of the report, the board may 11 make recommendations for legislation. The report must be submitted on or before September 12 15, 2018.

13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
