

# Senate Bill 5516

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## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for certain biennial expenses.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for distribution as grants-in-aid, for program costs and to purchase services.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain federal funds.

Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from certain federal funds received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits payment by department of expenses related to state education lottery bonds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Education; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

**(1) Operations..... \$ 76,596,811**

**(2) Oregon School for the Deaf..... \$ 12,412,966**

**SECTION 2. There are appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, which are to be distributed as grants-in-aid, for program costs and to purchase services, for the following purposes:**

**(1) Early intervention services and early childhood special education programs ..... \$169,072,840**

**(2) Other special education programs..... \$ 47,982,975**

**(3) Blind and Visually Impaired Student Fund ..... \$ 1,034,633**

**(4) Nutrition programs..... \$ 2,090,518**

**(5) Funding for dropout prevention**

13       **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 14 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment  
 15 of expenses, other than expenses described in sections 6 and 8 of this 2017 Act, from fees,  
 16 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and  
 17 federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education, for the following pur-  
 18 poses:

- 19       (1) Operations..... \$196,437,138
- 20       (2) Oregon School for the Deaf..... \$ 13,420,434
- 21       (3) Youth Corrections
- 22           Education Program..... \$ 17,113,445

23       **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 24 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment  
 25 of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in sections 5 and 8 of this 2017  
 26 Act, collected or received by the Department of Education, for the following purposes:

- 27       (1) Operations..... \$ 90,979,924
- 28       (2) Oregon School for the Deaf..... \$ 514,272
- 29       (3) Youth Corrections
- 30           Education Program..... \$ 2,304,640

31       **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 32 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment  
 33 of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from federal funds, other than those  
 34 described in sections 4 and 8 of this 2017 Act, received by the Department of Education, for  
 35 the following purposes:

- 36       (1) Early learning programs..... \$115,859,736
- 37       (2) Youth development programs... \$ 3,191,561
- 38       (3) All other grants ..... \$840,923,122

39       **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 40 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment  
 41 of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues,  
 42 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or  
 43 received by the Department of Education for programs other than those specified in sections  
 44 3 and 8 of this 2017 Act, for the following purposes:

- 45       (1) Early learning programs..... \$ 11,580,868

1       (2) Youth development programs... \$ 6,281,409

2       (3) All other grants..... \$ 81,347,466

3       **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$651,225  
4 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of  
5 expenses by the Department of Education from lottery moneys allocated from the Oregon  
6 Education Fund to the department for debt service on outstanding state education lottery  
7 bonds.

8       **SECTION 8.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, the following expenditures by the  
9 Department of Education are not limited:

10       (1) Moneys from the School Lunch Revolving Account, Education Training Revolving  
11 Account and Common School Fund; and

12       (2) Expenditures for grants-in-aid and purchased services from federal funds received by  
13 the Department of Education from the United States Department of Agriculture.

14       **SECTION 9.** This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect  
16 July 1, 2017.

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
