

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5516

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following
4 purposes:

5 (1) Operations..... \$ 77,167,794

6 (2) Oregon School for the Deaf..... \$ 12,317,072

7 “**SECTION 2.** There are appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium
8 beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, which are to be dis-
9 tributed as grants-in-aid, for program costs and to purchase services, for the following pur-
10 poses:

11 (1) Early intervention services
12 and early childhood special
13 education programs \$175,014,948

14 (2) Other special education
15 programs..... \$ 48,980,693

16 (3) Nutrition programs..... \$ 2,090,517

17 (4) Other K-12 grant-in-aid
18 programs..... \$ 51,634,644

19 (5) Oregon prekindergarten
20 program \$152,334,645

21 (6) Other early learning
22 programs..... \$ 95,606,056

23 (7) Youth development programs... \$ 13,151,091

24 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
25 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment
26 of expenses, other than expenses described in sections 6 and 10 of this 2017 Act, from fees,
27 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and
28 federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education, for the following pur-
29 poses:

30 (1) Operations..... \$ 39,120,017

31 (2) Oregon School for the Deaf..... \$ 6,025,702

32 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
33 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment
34 of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in sections 5 and 10 of this 2017
35 Act, collected or received by the Department of Education, for the following purposes:

- 1 (1) Operations..... \$ 80,093,895
- 2 (2) Oregon School for the Deaf..... \$ 264,004

3 “SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
4 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment
5 of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from federal funds, other than those
6 described in sections 4 and 10 of this 2017 Act, received by the Department of Education, for
7 the following purposes:

- 8 (1) Early learning programs..... \$121,035,508
- 9 (2) Youth development programs... \$ 750,000
- 10 (3) All other grants..... \$851,958,120

11 “SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
12 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment
13 of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues,
14 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or
15 received by the Department of Education for programs other than those specified in sections
16 3 and 10 of this 2017 Act, for the following purposes:

- 17 (1) Early learning programs..... \$ 11,580,868
- 18 (2) Youth development programs... \$ 6,281,409
- 19 (3) All other grants..... \$102,588,037

20 “SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
21 \$651,225 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for
22 payment of expenses by the Department of Education from lottery moneys allocated from
23 the Oregon Education Fund to the department for debt service on outstanding state educa-
24 tion lottery bonds.

25 “SECTION 8. There is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium
26 beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$19,851,315 for debt service
27 on Article XI-P general obligation bonds.

28 “SECTION 9. Notwithstanding section 2, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure
29 98 (2016)), there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning
30 July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$170,000,000 for deposit in the High
31 School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Fund.

32 “SECTION 10. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, the following expenditures by the
33 Department of Education are not limited:

34 “(1) Moneys from the School Lunch Revolving Account, Education Training Revolving
35 Account and Common School Fund; and

36 “(2) Expenditures for grants-in-aid and purchased services from federal funds received
37 by the Department of Education from the United States Department of Agriculture.

38 “SECTION 11. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
39 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
40 July 1, 2017.”.
