

Senate Bill 5518

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Environmental Quality for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, specified bond proceeds and specified federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery bond proceeds and general obligation bond proceeds.

Limits biennial expenditures from lottery moneys allocated from Parks and Natural Resources Fund to department.

Limits biennial expenditures of lottery moneys for debt service.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Environmental Quality; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the**
7 **following purposes:**

8 (1) Air quality..... \$ 12,947,057

9 (2) Water quality..... \$ 23,378,243

10 (3) Land quality..... \$ 1,151,461

11 (4) Debt service..... \$ 4,911,681

12 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
13 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment**
14 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the**
15 **proceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from congestion mitigation**
16 **and air quality grants, drinking water protection, beach bacteria monitoring, laboratory ac-**
17 **creditation and woodstove grants and for smoke monitoring laboratory services, but exclud-**
18 **ing lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the**
19 **Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:**

20 (1) Air quality..... \$ 57,429,583

21 (2) Water quality..... \$ 26,881,568

22 (3) Land quality..... \$ 66,444,957

23 (4) Agency management..... \$ 31,486,778

24 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**

1 \$10,362,251 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for
2 payment of expenses from lottery bond proceeds and certain general obligation bond proceeds
3 collected or received by the Department of Environmental Quality for Portland Harbor, and
4 bond-related costs for the Environmental Data Management System and Portland Harbor.

5 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
6 \$4,386,715 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for
7 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources
8 Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to implement
9 Article XV, section 4 (8), of the Oregon Constitution.

10 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$970,108
11 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of
12 expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-
13 opment Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality for debt service.

14 **SECTION 6.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, the following expenditures by the
15 Department of Environmental Quality are not limited:

16 (1) Expenditures for debt service and debt service administrative costs related to the
17 Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund and the Pollution Control Fund; and

18 (2) Expenditures made for loans from the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund and
19 loans from the Pollution Control Fund.

20 **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
21 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment
22 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2017 Act, col-
23 lected or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:

- 24 (1) Air quality..... \$ 10,172,839
- 25 (2) Water quality..... \$ 11,499,202
- 26 (3) Land quality..... \$ 7,322,597

27 **SECTION 8.** This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
29 July 1, 2017.

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
