Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in sections 9 and 10 of this 2017 Act, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the following purposes:

Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from bond proceeds and other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from the proceeds of lottery bonds for the purposes of a grant to Linn-Benton Community College for the Advanced Transportation Technology Center.

"SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$8,240,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from the Sports Lottery Account for the benefit of Oregon public universities.".
