

# Senate Bill 5525

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Higher Education Coordinating Commission. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Higher Education Coordinating Commission; and de-  
3 claring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. For purposes of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a fee of**  
6 **\$1,000 for application by an Oregon career school for review and approval of any new pro-**  
7 **grams proposed to be offered by the school, adopted by the Higher Education Coordinating**  
8 **Commission and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is ap-**  
9 **proved.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
12 **July 1, 2017.**
