Senate Bill 5526

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain federal funds. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the

20 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 21 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment 22 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and 23 Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security 24 Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but 25 excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received 26 by the Department of Human Services, for the following purposes:
