## Senate Bill 585

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires each state agency to report monthly to Oregon Department of Administrative Services and Legislative Fiscal Officer information about agency's proposed and final rules. Requires department to publish on Internet specified information regarding agency rulemaking. Prohibits rules from taking effect less than six months after publication by department on Internet unless exception criteria are met.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to published reports about agency rulemaking.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Sections 2 and 3 of this 2017 Act are added to and made a part of ORS 5 chapter 183.
  - <u>SECTION 2.</u> An agency shall submit to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and to the Legislative Fiscal Officer each calendar month, in the form and manner prescribed by the department and the officer, the following information:
  - (1) For each rule that the agency expects to propose or make final during the next 12 months:
    - (a) A summary of the nature of the rule.
    - (b) The objectives of and legal basis for the rule.
  - (c) The stage of the rulemaking on the date the report is submitted.
- 14 (d) Whether the rule is subject to review under ORS 183.405.
  - (2) For each rule for which the agency has sent a notice under ORS 183.335 (1) and that the agency expects to make final during the next 12 months:
    - (a) An approximate schedule for completing action on the rule;
      - (b) An estimate of the cost to implement the rule; and
  - (c) Any estimate of the economic effects of the rule, including any estimate of the net effect that the rule will have on the number of jobs in this state, that was considered in drafting the rule.
  - SECTION 3. (1) Not later than 30 days after the submission of information under section 2 of this 2017 Act, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make such information publicly available on the Internet.
  - (2) Not later than October 1 of each year, the department shall publish on the Internet, for the previous year, the following:
- 27 (a) The information that the department received from each agency under section 2 of this 2017 Act.
  - (b) The number of proposed and final rules and a list of the rules by number.
  - (c) The number of agency actions and a list of each action taken by each agency that:

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1 (A) Repealed a rule;

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- (B) Reduced the scope of a rule;
- 3 (C) Reduced the cost of a rule; or
  - (D) Accelerated the expiration date of a rule.
  - (d) The total cost of all rules proposed or final, without reducing the cost by any offsetting benefits.
    - (e) The number of rules for which an estimate of the cost of the rule was not available.
  - (f) The analysis of the costs or benefits, if conducted, for each proposed rule and each final rule adopted by an agency.
  - (g) The number of rules and a list of the rules for which the agency completed a periodic review under ORS 183.405.
  - (h) The number of rules and a list of each rule reviewed by Legislative Counsel under ORS 183.720.
  - (i) The number of rules and a list of each rule for which the Legislative Counsel issued a negative determination under ORS 183.720.

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
