## Senate Bill 610

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for Oregon Employer Workforce Training Program, local workforce investment boards and Oregon Youth Conservation Corps.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of job training programs through the Higher Education Coordinating Commission; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000 for the Oregon Employer Workforce Training Program.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,750,000 for local workforce investment boards for youth work experience programs.

SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,250,000 for the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps for grants for the Oregon Community Stewardship Corps and the Summer Conservation Corps.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
