Senate Bill 627

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires agency to cite to publicly available scientific evidence for cost of compliance effect on small businesses reported in notice of intent to adopt, amend or repeal rule.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 183.336 is amended to read:
6	183.336. (1) The statement of cost of compliance effect on small businesses required by ORS
7	183.335 (2)(b)(E) must include:
8	(a) An estimate of the number of small businesses subject to the proposed rule and identification
9	of the types of businesses and industries with small businesses subject to the proposed rule;
10	(b) A brief description of the projected reporting, recordkeeping and other administrative activ-
11	ities required for compliance with the proposed rule, including costs of professional services;
12	(c) An identification of equipment, supplies, labor and increased administration required for
13	compliance with the proposed rule; [and]
14	(d) A description of the manner in which the agency proposing the rule involved small busi-
15	nesses in the development of the rule; and
16	(e) A citation to publicly available scientific evidence that supports the agency's state-
17	ment of cost of compliance effect on small businesses.
18	(2) An agency shall utilize available information in complying with the requirements of this
19	section.
20	(3) Notwithstanding ORS 183.335 (13), the statement of cost of compliance effect on small
21	businesses must be based upon or supported by an evidentiary record.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> ORS 183.540 is added to and made a part of ORS 183.325 to 183.410.
