SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands definition of "vehicle of special interest" to include Humvees.

2	Relating to vehicles of special interest; amending ORS 801.605.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 801.605 is amended to read:
5	801.605. "Vehicle of special interest" means any American or foreign made vehicle that is
6	maintained as a collector's item and that:
7	(1) Is a street rod under ORS 801.513; [or]
8	(2) Is a high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicle and originally manufactured for mil-
9	itary use; or
10	[(2)] (3) Complies with all of the following:
11	(a) The vehicle must be:
12	(A) At least 25 years old as dated from any current year; or
13	(B) Sanctioned as a vehicle of special interest by an established organization that provides for
14	recognition of vehicles of special interest.
15	(b) If the vehicle is a reconstructed vehicle, the Department of Transportation must determine
16	that the vehicle has been reconstructed with substantially original parts and that the vehicle oth-
17	erwise complies with this section.
