Senate Bill 65

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Authorizes Psychiatric Security Review Board to establish restorative justice program. Provides that documents or oral communications related to program are confidential, not admissible in subsequent proceeding and not public records.

2	Relating to the Psychiatric Security Review Board.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Psychiatric Security Review Board may develop a restorative justice
5	program to assist the recovery of crime victims when a person is found guilty except for
6	insanity of a crime or responsible except for insanity for an act.
7	(2) Any documents or oral communications created, submitted or provided for use in the
8	restorative justice program:
9	(a) Are confidential and may not be disclosed or used by the board, restorative justice
10	program staff or volunteers or restorative justice program participants except as expressly
11	authorized by the rules established pursuant to subsection (3) of this section;
12	(b) Are not admissible as evidence in any subsequent administrative or judicial proceed-
13	ing; and
14	(c) Are not public records for the purposes of ORS 192.410 to 192.505.
15	(3) The board may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.
