Senate Bill 692

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Public Defense Services Commission for pre-entry pilot program.

Directs Public Defense Services Commission to report on results of pilot program to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before February 1, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Public Defense Services Commission; and declaring
an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

6 ated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out

7 of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for Metropolitan Public Defender Services, and

8 an office providing public defender services for a rural county, for a pre-entry pilot program.

9 SECTION 2. The Public Defense Services Commission shall study the results of the pre-

10 entry pilot program described in section 1 of this 2017 Act and report to the interim com-

11 mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under

12 ORS 192.245 on or before February 1, 2019.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
July 1, 2017.
