

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 693

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 4, after “802.550,” insert “807.020,”.

2 On page 30, after line 30, insert:

4 **“MEMBERS OF COMMISSIONED CORPS OF**  
5 **NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION**

7 **“SECTION 39.** ORS 807.020 is amended to read:

8 “807.020. A person who is granted a driving privilege by this section may exercise the driving  
9 privilege described without violation of the requirements under ORS 807.010. A grant of driving  
10 privileges to operate a motor vehicle under this section is subject to suspension and revocation the  
11 same as other driving privileges granted under the vehicle code. This section is in addition to any  
12 exemptions from the vehicle code under ORS 801.026. The following persons are granted the de-  
13 scribed driving privileges:

14 “(1) A person who is not a resident of this state or who has been a resident of this state for less  
15 than 30 days may operate a motor vehicle without an Oregon license or driver permit if the person  
16 holds a current out-of-state license issued to the person. For the purpose of this subsection, a person  
17 is a resident of this state if the person meets the residency requirements described in ORS 807.062.  
18 To qualify under this subsection, the person must have the out-of-state license or driver permit in  
19 the person’s possession. A person is not granted driving privileges under this subsection:

20 “(a) If the person is under the minimum age required to be eligible for driving privileges under  
21 ORS 807.060;

22 “(b) During a period of suspension or revocation by this state or any other jurisdiction of driv-  
23 ing privileges or of the right to apply for a license or driver permit issued by this state or any other  
24 jurisdiction; or

25 “(c) That exceed the driving privileges granted to the person by the out-of-state license or driver  
26 permit.

27 “(2) A [*person in*] **member of the Armed Forces of the United States or the commissioned**  
28 **corps of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration** may operate a motor vehicle  
29 without an Oregon license or driver permit if the person is operating a motor vehicle in the course  
30 of the person’s duties in the Armed Forces **or the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Adminis-**  
31 **tration.**

32 “(3) A person without a license or driver permit may operate a road roller or road machinery  
33 that is not required to be registered under the laws of this state.

34 “(4) A person without a license or driver permit may temporarily operate, draw, move or propel  
35 a farm tractor or implement of husbandry.

1           “(5) A person without a license or driver permit may operate a motor vehicle to demonstrate  
2 driving ability during the course of an examination administered under ORS 807.070 for the purpose  
3 of qualifying for a license or driver permit. This subsection only applies when an authorized exam-  
4 iner is in a seat beside the driver of the motor vehicle.

5           “(6) Driving privileges for snowmobiles are exclusively as provided in ORS 821.150.

6           “(7) Driving privileges for Class I all-terrain vehicles are exclusively as provided in ORS 821.170.

7           “(8) Driving privileges for Class III all-terrain vehicles are exclusively as provided in ORS  
8 821.172.

9           “(9) Driving privileges for Class IV all-terrain vehicles are exclusively as provided in ORS  
10 821.176.

11           “(10) A person without a license or driver permit may operate a golf cart in accordance with  
12 an ordinance adopted under ORS 810.070.

13           “(11) The spouse of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States on active duty **or the**  
14 **spouse of a member of the commissioned corps of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric**  
15 **Administration** who is accompanying the member on assignment in this state may operate a motor  
16 vehicle if the spouse has a current out-of-state license or driver permit issued to the spouse by an-  
17 other state in the spouse’s possession.

18           “(12) A person who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States on active duty **or a**  
19 **member of the commissioned corps of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration**  
20 may operate a motor vehicle if the person has a current out-of-state license or driver permit in the  
21 person’s possession that is issued to the person by the person’s state of domicile or by the Armed  
22 Forces of the United States in a foreign country. Driving privileges described under this subsection  
23 that are granted by the Armed Forces apply only for a period of 45 days from the time the person  
24 returns to the United States.

25           “(13) A person who does not hold a motorcycle endorsement may operate a motorcycle if the  
26 person is:

27           “(a) Within an enclosed cab; or

28           “(b) Operating a vehicle designed to travel with three wheels in contact with the ground at  
29 speeds of less than 15 miles per hour.

30           “(14) A person may operate a bicycle that is not an electric assisted bicycle without any grant  
31 of driving privileges.

32           “(15) A person may operate an electric assisted bicycle without a driver license or driver permit  
33 if the person is 16 years of age or older.

34           “(16) A person may operate a motor assisted scooter without a driver license or driver permit  
35 if the person is 16 years of age or older.

36           “(17) A person who is not a resident of this state or who has been a resident of this state for  
37 less than 30 days may operate a motor vehicle without an Oregon license or driver permit if the  
38 person is at least 15 years of age and has in the person’s possession a current out-of-state equivalent  
39 of a Class C instruction driver permit issued to the person. For the purpose of this subsection, a  
40 person is a resident of this state if the person meets the residency requirements described in ORS  
41 807.062. A person operating a motor vehicle under authority of this subsection has the same privi-  
42 leges and is subject to the same restrictions as a person operating under the authority of a Class  
43 C instruction driver permit issued as provided in ORS 807.280.

44           “(18) A person may operate an electric personal assistive mobility device without any grant of  
45 driving privileges if the person is 16 years of age or older.”.
