## Senate Bill 726

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Department of Corrections to conduct study on impact of prison visitation on offender recidivism and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2018.

Sunsets January 2, 2019.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to prisons.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections shall conduct a study on the impact of prison visitation on offender recidivism and present the results of the study, along with any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2018.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.
