

Senate Bill 728

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to study law enforcement. Requires report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to law enforcement.

Sunsets January 2, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to law enforcement; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall study law**
5 **enforcement in this state. The department shall submit findings and recommendations for**
6 **legislation to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to law enforcement**
7 **not later than December 31, 2017.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2018.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
