

Senate Bill 729

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study public records. Requires report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to public records.

Sunsets January 2, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to public records; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall study public re-**
5 **ords in this state. The department shall submit findings and recommendations for legis-**
6 **lation to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to public records not later**
7 **than December 30, 2017.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2018.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
