

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 762**

1 In line 4 of the printed bill, after the period delete the rest of the line and lines 5 through 9 and
2 insert “(1)(a) A person who contacts emergency medical services or a law enforcement agency to
3 report a sexual assault crime, or to obtain medical or law enforcement assistance for a victim of a
4 sexual assault crime, is immune from arrest or prosecution for a violation of ORS 471.430 if the
5 evidence of the violation was obtained because the person contacted emergency medical services or
6 a law enforcement agency.

7 “(b) A person who is the victim of a sexual assault crime is immune from arrest or prosecution
8 for a violation of ORS 471.430 if the evidence of the violation was obtained because any person
9 contacted emergency medical services or a law enforcement agency to report the crime or to obtain
10 medical or law enforcement assistance for the victim.”
