

Senate Bill 776

Sponsored by Senator GIROD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation related to consideration of economies of scale when calculating State School Fund distributions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to consideration of economies of scale for school funding.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall conduct an evaluation to determine:**

5 **(a) Whether economies of scale should be a factor when calculating distributions of the**
6 **State School Fund under ORS 327.013; and**

7 **(b) If applicable, how to make economies of scale a factor when calculating distributions**
8 **of the State School Fund under ORS 327.013.**

9 **(2) The department shall submit a report on the evaluation described in subsection (1)**
10 **of this section, including any recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of**
11 **the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than October 15, 2018.**
