

Senate Bill 784

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE (at the request of Terri Myzak)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires insurer to reimburse out-of-network women's health care provider at same rate as in-network women's health care provider.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to women's health care providers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

6 (a) **"Health benefit plan" has the meaning given that term in ORS 743B.005.**

7 (b) **"Women's health care provider" has the meaning given that term in ORS 743B.222.**

8 (2) **An insurer offering a health benefit plan that reimburses the cost of services provided**
9 **by a women's health care provider must reimburse an out-of-network provider of such ser-**
10 **vices at the same rate as in-network providers of such services.**

11 (3) **This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.**
