Senate Bill 786

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires health care regulatory boards to allow health care practitioner to use telehealth when health care practitioner determines telehealth is appropriate.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to telehealth.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "telehealth" means the delivery of clinical in-5 formation and health services to a patient by a health care practitioner from a distance us-6 ing electronic telecommunications technology.

7 (2) A health professional regulatory board shall allow a health care practitioner that the 8 board regulates to use telehealth when, in the professional judgment of the health care 9 practitioner, the use of telehealth is an appropriate manner in which to provide the health

10 service that the health care practitioner is authorized to provide.

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
