## AN ACT

Relating to provision of veteran services in rural areas of this state; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> No later than February 1, 2018, the Advisory Committee appointed under ORS 406.210 shall review, consider and report to the interim legislative committees relating to veterans regarding the program described in Senate Bill 832 (2017) as introduced. The Advisory Committee shall evaluate the merits of the program and the likelihood that the program will enhance the provision of veteran services to rural areas of this state. The report must address funding priorities for the program's implementation and make recommendations for legislation that may be introduced to accomplish one or more purposes and objectives of the program.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 2018.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
