Senate Bill 848

SUMMARY

Specifies that it is unlawful employment practice for employer to require, as condition of employment, that employee or prospective employee obtain or receive vaccination.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 659A
5	SECTION 2. (1) It is an unlawful employment practice for any employer to require, as a
6	condition of employment, that an employee or prospective employee obtain or receive any
7	vaccination.
8	(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply if an applicable collective bargaining
9	agreement requires the receipt of any vaccination.
