## Senate Bill 851

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Oregon Military Department to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2018, regarding implementation of Oregon Code of Military Justice.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to the Oregon Military Department; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2018, the Oregon Military Department shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees on veterans' affairs and military affairs re-5 garding implementation of the Oregon Code of Military Justice in this state. 6 7 (2) The report shall include a summary of implementation barriers and may include rec-8 ommendations for legislative changes. SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage. 11 12
