

Senate Bill 874

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON MARIJUANA REGULATION

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs marijuana businesses licensed by Oregon Liquor Control Commission, and persons performing work for or on behalf of licensees, to report violations of marijuana laws and rules to commission.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to cannabis.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.010 to**
5 **475B.395.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A licensee, and a person performing work for or on behalf of a licensee,**
7 **must report to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, in a form and manner prescribed by**
8 **the commission, any violation of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395, 475B.550 to 475B.590 or 475B.600**
9 **to 475B.655, or of a rule adopted under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395, 475B.550 to 475B.590 or**
10 **475B.600 to 475B.655, that is known to the licensee or person.**

11 **(2) In accordance with the provisions of ORS chapter 183, the commission shall suspend**
12 **or revoke the license of a licensee if:**

13 **(a) The licensee violates this section; or**

14 **(b) A person who performs work for or on behalf of the licensee violates this section.**
