## Senate Bill 887

Sponsored by Senator TAYLOR

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs school districts to identify certain students to receive information about opportunities related to advanced placement examinations.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to advanced placement examinations; and declaring an emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) Prior to February 15 of each year, each school district shall: (a) Identify high school students who: 5 (A) Are enrolled in a course that correlates to a subject for which a student may take 6 7 an advanced placement examination; or 8 (B) Demonstrate academic potential to excel at an advanced placement examination; and (b) Notify the students and the parents of the students identified under paragraph (a) of 9 this subsection of the opportunities related to advanced placement examinations. 10 (2) In addition to the notice described in subsection (1) of this section, a school district 11 12 shall provide information about the opportunities related to advanced placement examinations in student handbooks and on the website for the school district. 13 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act first applies to the 2017-2018 school year. 14 SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 16 July 1, 2017. 17
