## Enrolled Senate Bill 890

CHAPTER	

## AN ACT

Relating to privileged city information disclosed to elected city auditor; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "legally protected material" means:

- (a) Information and records of a city that are protected by attorney-client privilege held by the city; and
  - (b) Attorney work product prepared in the course of providing legal services to the city.
- (2) The disclosure of legally protected material by a city, or any officer, employee or agent of the city, to the elected auditor of the city, or any employee or agent of the elected auditor who is employed for the purpose of auditing or investigating the city, does not waive the privilege with respect to any other person, to the extent the legally protected material is disclosed for the purpose of an audit or investigation.

SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
