SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides that disclosure of legally privileged city information and records to elected city auditor does not waive privilege with respect to any other person, to extent information and records are disclosed for purpose of audit or investigation.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The disclosure of legally privileged information and records of a city by the
5	city, or any officer, employee or agent of the city, to the elected auditor of the city, or any
6	employee or agent of the elected auditor who is employed for the purpose of auditing or in-
7	vestigating the city, does not waive the privilege with respect to any other person, to the
8	extent the information and records are disclosed for the purpose of an audit or investigation.
9	SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
11	on its passage.
