Senate Bill 890

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that disclosure of legally privileged city information and records to elected city auditor does_not waive privilege with respect to any other person.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to privileged city information disclosed to elected city auditor; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The disclosure of legally privileged information and records of a city by the
5	city, or any officer, employee or agent of the city, to the elected auditor of the city, or any
6	employee or agent of the elected auditor who is employed for the purpose of auditing or in-
7	vestigating the city, does not waive the privilege with respect to any other person.
8	SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
