

Senate Bill 890

Sponsored by Senator TAYLOR

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that disclosure of legally privileged city information and records to elected city auditor does not waive privilege with respect to any other person.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to privileged city information disclosed to elected city auditor; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The disclosure of legally privileged information and records of a city by the**
5 **city, or any officer, employee or agent of the city, to the elected auditor of the city, or any**
6 **employee or agent of the elected auditor who is employed for the purpose of auditing or in-**
7 **vestigating the city, does not waive the privilege with respect to any other person.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
