

# Senate Bill 93

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Department of Consumer and Business Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases from \$250,000 to \$1 million maximum amount credited to Workers' Memorial Scholarship Account from civil penalties recovered for violations of occupational health and safety standards.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to amount credited to Workers' Memorial Scholarship Account from civil penalties recov-  
3 ered for violations of certain occupational standards; amending ORS 654.200.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 654.200 is amended to read:

6 654.200. (1) There is established in the Consumer and Business Services Fund the Workers'  
7 Memorial Scholarship Account. Only the interest earned on moneys in the account shall be used  
8 by the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the establishment and  
9 administration of a scholarship program to pay education related expenses of the spouses and chil-  
10 dren of workers who are killed or who have received a permanent total disability award from injury  
11 on the job. A maximum of [*\$250,000*] **\$1 million** to carry out the provisions of this section [*shall*]  
12 **may** be credited to the account from civil penalties recovered pursuant to ORS 654.086.

13 (2) The director shall consult with the Safe Employment Education and Training Advisory  
14 Committee established pursuant to ORS 654.189 in determining the appropriate scholarship standard  
15 and in selecting the recipients.
