

Senate Bill 94

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases threshold for estimated cost at which construction project sites must provide sanitary facilities by changing amount that triggers requirement from \$1 million to \$1.75 million. Allows Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services to adjust threshold amount based on change in Consumer Price Index.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to requirement that construction project sites provide sanitary facilities when cost esti-
3 mates meet certain threshold; amending ORS 654.150.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 654.150 is amended to read:

6 654.150. (1) At the site of every construction project estimated to cost [*\$1 million*] **\$1.75 million**
7 or more the employer or owner of such place of employment shall provide toilet facilities and facil-
8 ities for maintaining personal cleanliness for the use of employees on the construction project. Flush
9 toilets shall be provided and the washing facilities shall consist of warm water, wash basins and
10 soap. A building or a mobile, self-contained unit may be provided for such facilities. The number,
11 types and maintenance of facilities shall conform to minimum standards set by the Director of the
12 Department of Consumer and Business Services.

13 (2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to highway construction or maintenance projects
14 or to electricity, water, sewer or gas transmission facility construction or maintenance projects.

15 (3) The director may, by order, exempt or partially exempt[,] individual or classes of con-
16 struction projects from the requirements of subsection (1) of this section when conditions are such
17 that compliance is impractical or impossible.

18 (4) **The director may issue rules to revise the estimated construction project cost de-**
19 **scribed in subsection (1) of this section based on changes in the Portland-Salem, OR-WA**
20 **Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All Items as published by the Bureau**
21 **of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.**
