

Senate Bill 942

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to conduct statewide study regarding child safety no later than July 1, 2018.

Requires department to submit report regarding study to interim legislative committees no later than November 1, 2018.

Sunset January 2, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to child safety; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2018, the Department of Human Services shall conduct a statewide study regarding child safety. The department shall collaborate with the Department of Education and the Office of Child Care in conducting the study under this subsection.

(2) No later than November 1, 2018, the Department of Human Services shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees related to child welfare regarding the study conducted in accordance with subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
