A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to noncompetition agreements with home care workers.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 653.295, a noncompetition agreement as defined in ORS 653.295 made in the context of an employment relationship or contract with a home care worker as defined in ORS 410.600 is voidable by the home care worker and may not be enforced by a court of this state.
