4 Whereas Corporal Jeremy M. Loveless was survived by his wife, Melissa Loveless, his daughter,  
5 Chloe Loveless, his parents, Connie and Michael Loveless, and his brothers, Nicholas Loveless and  
6 Brandon Loveless; and

7 Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans was born on March 6, 1947; and

8 Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans was born on December 21, 1948; and

9 Whereas the Evans brothers and their family resided in Klamath Falls, Oregon; and

10 Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans was a United States Army soldier assigned to  
11 156th Aviation Company Army Security Agency (ASA), 224th ASA Aviation Battalion, 509th ASA  
12 Group, United States Army, Vietnam (USARV); and

13 Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans was a 33G20 ECM/DF Systems Repairman; and

14 Whereas Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans died in a fixed-wing aircraft accident in Phong  
15 Dinh Province, South Vietnam, on November 24, 1970, at the age of 23; and

16 Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans was a United States Army soldier assigned to 117th  
17 Assault Helicopter Company, 214th Combat Aviation Battalion, 127th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation  
18 Brigade, USARV; and

19 Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans was a 35K20 Avionics Mechanic; and

20 Whereas Specialist Four David Lynn Evans died in a helicopter crash during a hostile engage-  
21 ment in Long An Province, South Vietnam, on October 24, 1968, at the age of 19; and

22 Whereas the father of the Evans brothers, James Earl Evans (1926-1983), was a United States  
23 Air Force veteran who served in World War II and the Korean War; and

24 Whereas David Lynn Evans (1969-2011), the son of Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans and the  
25 namesake of his uncle, was a soldier in the United States Army National Guard who served in the  
26 Iraq War; and

27 Whereas the Evans family of Klamath Falls is one of only 39 families nationwide, and four  
28 families in Oregon, to lose two sons in the Vietnam War; and

29 Whereas the citizens of Klamath Falls and Klamath County and the Vietnam Veterans of  
30 America wish to honor the sacrifice of the Evans family in the Vietnam War; now, therefore,

31 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

32 That we, the members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Corporal  
33 Jeremy M. Loveless, Specialist Six Norman Francis Evans and Specialist Four David Lynn Evans  
34 for their service to their country.
