**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2579**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “offenders” delete the rest of
2 the line and insert a period.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Reentry support and services’ has the meaning given that term**
6 **in ORS 423.110.**

7 **“(b) ‘Sentence’ includes a period of incarceration, any period of**
8 **transitional leave, work release or program of conditional or super-**
9 **vised release authorized by law and any period of post-prison super-**
10 **vision.**

11 **“(c) ‘Youth correction facility’ has the meaning given that term in**
12 **ORS 420.005.**

13 **“(2) The Oregon Youth Authority may provide reentry support and**
14 **services for offenders who, having been committed to the legal and**
15 **physical custody of the Department of Corrections and thereafter**
16 **transferred to the physical custody of the authority under ORS 137.124**
17 **and 420.011, are released from a youth correction facility:**

18 **“(a) On any form of transitional leave, work release or program of**
19 **conditional or supervised release authorized by law; or**

20 **“(b) On post-prison supervision.**

21 **“(3) The authority may provide the reentry support and services to**

1 **an offender described in subsection (2) of this section until the earlier**
2 **of the following dates:**

3 **“(a) The date on which the offender attains 25 years of age; or**

4 **“(b) The date on which the offender completes the sentence for the**
5 **offense for which the offender was transferred to the physical custody**
6 **of the authority under ORS 137.124 and 420.011.**

7 **“(4) The authority, in collaboration with county community cor-**
8 **rections agencies and the Department of Corrections, shall adopt rules**
9 **to carry out the provisions of this section.”.**
