**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 516**

1 Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) Any court order or administrative order issued or**
3 **modified in a proceeding under ORS chapter 107, 108, 109, 110, 416, 419B**
4 **or 419C that contains an order for the payment of child support or**
5 **spousal support must specify an initial due date and year for the pay-**
6 **ment of support that is on the first day of a calendar month, with**
7 **subsequent payments due on the first day of each subsequent month**
8 **for which the support is payable.**

9 **“(2) For purposes of support enforcement, any support payment**
10 **that becomes due and payable on a day other than the first day of the**
11 **month in which the payment is due shall be enforceable by income**
12 **withholding as of the first day of that month.**

13 **“(3) Any court order or administrative order that contains an award**
14 **of child, medical or spousal support that accrues on other than a**
15 **monthly basis may, for income withholding and administrative support**
16 **billing purposes only, be converted to a monthly amount.**

17 **“(4) Support payments become delinquent only if not paid in full**
18 **within one month of the payment due date. A monthly child support**
19 **obligation that is to be paid in two or more installments does not be-**
20 **come delinquent until the obligation is not paid in full by the due date**
21 **for the first installment in the next month.**

1 **“(5) Subsections (2) and (3) of this section do not apply to the de-**
2 **termination or issuance of support arrearage liens, installment**
3 **arrearage liens, judgment liens, writs of garnishment or any other**
4 **action or proceeding that affects property rights under ORS chapter**
5 **18.”.**
