PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO **SENATE BILL 643**

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete "830.215 and 830.380" and in-1 sert "704.070". 2
- Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert: 3
- **"SECTION 1.** ORS 704.070 is amended to read: 4
- "704.070. (1) A person who acts or offers to act as an outfitter and guide 5 using boats to carry passengers on the waters of this state shall: 6
- "(a) Equip each nonmotorized boat that is under the direct operation of 7 an outfitter and guide or an employee of an outfitter and guide to carry 8 passengers on waters rated as class III or higher on a commonly accepted 9 scale of river difficulty with a rescue throw bag, complete with a length of 10 artificial fiber rope and a buoyant bag; 11
- 12 "(b) On any section of waters rated as class III or higher on a commonly accepted scale of river difficulty, require that all persons physically providing outfitting and guiding services and all passengers wear a properly secured United States Coast Guard approved personal flotation device of a type prescribed by rules adopted by the State Marine Board;
- "(c) If the outfitter and guide operates nonmotorized boats carrying pas-17 sengers on any section of waters rated as class III or higher on a commonly 18 accepted scale of river difficulty, require that all persons physically provid-19 ing outfitting and guiding services: 20
 - "(A) Prior to providing the services, have completed at least one trip on

- that section of waters in a nonmotorized boat; and
- 2 "(B) Have been trained in equipment preparation and boat rigging,
- 3 understanding and recognizing river characteristics and hazards, methods of
- 4 scouting rapids, methods of physically guiding boats through rapids, proper
- 5 client communication, how to provide paddling and safety instruction and
- 6 methods of river rescue techniques, including emergency procedures and
- 7 equipment recovery; [and]
- 8 "(d) If the outfitter and guide is a charter guide, ensure that the vessel
- 9 used to carry passengers complies with the equipment requirements for
- 10 charter vessels under ORS 830.450[.]; and
 - "(e) On any section of waters rated as class III or higher on a
- 12 commonly accepted scale of river difficulty, require that all persons
- 13 12 years of age or under wear a properly secured helmet of a type
- 14 prescribed by rules adopted by the board.
 - "(2) Subsection (1)(b) of this section does not apply to motorized boats
- that are inspected by the United States Coast Guard.
- "SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 704.070 by section 1 of this
- 18 2017 Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of
- 19 this 2017 Act.".
