## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2979

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "amending" and insert "creating new provisions; and amending".
- 3 On page 3, after line 36, insert:
- "SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 413.
- "SECTION 4. (1) If the Oregon Health Authority fails to make a timely determination on the renewal of medical assistance for a recipient who is enrolled in a coordinated care organization, the authority may not disenroll the recipient from the coordinated care organization before the earlier of:
- 11 "(a) The date the authority determines that the recipient is no 12 longer eligible for medical assistance; and
  - "(b) Six months after the renewal determination is due.
- "(2) The authority shall reimburse a coordinated care organization for services provided to a medical assistance recipient during the period described in subsection (1) of this section.
- "(3) The authority shall post to its website a quarterly report of the number of medical assistance recipients whose eligibility lapsed due to the failure of the authority to make a timely renewal determination."

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
