**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3135**

1 Delete lines 5 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 414.065 and 414.690, medical as-**
3 **sistance must reimburse, at a rate specified by the Oregon Health**
4 **Authority, the cost to:**

5 **“(1) Insert, postpartum, an intrauterine device or a progestin im-**
6 **plant in an individual who is eligible for medical assistance while the**
7 **individual is admitted to a hospital for labor and delivery; and**

8 **“(2) Remove, at any time, an intrauterine device or progestin im-**
9 **plant reimbursed under subsection (1) of this section regardless of**
10 **whether the individual is eligible for medical assistance.**

11 **“SECTION 3. (1) For the 24-month period following the effective**
12 **date of this 2017 Act, the Oregon Health Authority shall evaluate the**
13 **impact of section 2 of this 2017 Act on the:**

14 **“(a) Utilization of long acting contraceptives by medical assistance**
15 **recipients who are of reproductive age;**

16 **“(b) Satisfaction of women of reproductive age with the**
17 **contraceptive services available in the medical assistance program;**

18 **“(c) Quality measures for coordinated care organizations; and**

19 **“(d) Total cost of the medical assistance program.**

20 **“(2) No later than July 1, 2019, the authority shall report its findings**
21 **for the first 12 months of the period described in subsection (1) of this**

1 section to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related
2 to health.

3 “(3) No later than July 1, 2020, the authority shall report its findings
4 for the entire period described in subsection (1) of this section to the
5 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health.

6 “SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2,
7 2021.”.

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
