**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1057**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “279A.025,” insert “471.705,”.

2 On page 37, after line 9, insert:

3 **“SECTION 84a.** ORS 471.705 is amended to read:

4 “471.705. (1) There is created the Oregon Liquor Control Commission,  
5 consisting of [*five persons*] **seven commissioners** appointed by the Gover-  
6 nor. One [*member shall*] **commissioner must** be from among the [*bona*  
7 *fide*] residents of each congressional district of [*the*] **this** state. **One addi-**  
8 **tional commissioner must be from eastern Oregon. One additional**  
9 **commissioner must be from western Oregon.** One [*member shall*] **com-**  
10 **missioner must** be from the food and alcoholic beverage retail industry.  
11 Not more than [*three*] **four** commissioners [*shall*] **may** be of the same poli-  
12 tical party [*and one shall be designated by*]. The Governor **shall designate**  
13 **one commissioner** to be chairperson of the commission. The commissioners  
14 are entitled to compensation and expenses as provided in ORS 292.495.

15 “(2) Each commissioner at the time of appointment [*and qualification*  
16 *shall*] **must** be a resident of this state and [*shall*] **must** have resided in this  
17 state for at least five years next preceding appointment and qualification.  
18 [*The*] **Each** commissioner [*shall*] **must** be an elector [*therein*] **in this state**  
19 and **may not be** less than 30 years of age. [*A commissioner shall cease to hold*  
20 *office*] **The term of office of a commissioner terminates** if the commis-  
21 sioner ceases to possess the residency or industry qualification for appoint-

1 ment *[and]*. **If the term of office of a commissioner terminates under**  
2 **this subsection**, the Governor shall appoint a qualified individual to com-  
3 plete the unexpired term **of the commissioner**.

4 “[~~(2)~~] **(3)** The term of office of a commissioner *[shall be]* **is** four years from  
5 the time of appointment and qualification and until a successor qualifies **for**  
6 **appointment**. The terms of the commissioners *[shall]* commence April 1. *[In*  
7 *case any]* **If a** commissioner is allowed to hold *[over]* **office** after the expi-  
8 ration of *[the]* **a** term, the *[successor shall be appointed]* **Governor shall**  
9 **appoint the successor** for the *[balance]* **remainder** of the unexpired term.  
10 *[Vacancies in the commission shall be filled by the Governor for the unexpired*  
11 *term.]* **If a vacancy occurs in the commission, the Governor shall ap-**  
12 **point the successor for the remainder of the unexpired term.** Each  
13 commissioner is eligible for reappointment, but *[no person shall be]* **an in-**  
14 **dividual is not** eligible to serve for more than two full terms.

15 “[~~(3)~~] **(4)** *[All]* Appointments of commissioners by the Governor **under**  
16 **this section** are subject to confirmation by the Senate pursuant to section  
17 4, Article III, Oregon Constitution.”.
